This presentation will discuss some of the key differences between QI and research in nursing:

- Quality Improvement (QI) aims to enhance patient care and healthcare processes within a specific setting and may not require ethics review if it focuses solely on internal improvements with minimal risk
- Research seeks to generate new, generalizable knowledge that can be applied broadly across settings and requires ethics approval due to potential risks to participants and the intent to publish findings
- Whether you're working in research or curious about how to start a QI project in your clinical area, join this discussion and bring your research questions
