The following Meeting Standing Rules are designed to facilitate progress at this meeting of the Nurses and Nurse Practitioners of BC (the Association), to include members in orderly discussion, and to ensure courtesy, fairness, and equality for all.

1. This Meeting will be conducted in accordance with the *Societies Act*, the Constitution and By-Laws of the Association, and Sturgis Standard Code of Parliamentary Procedure (rules of order).
2. This Annual General Meeting is for the purpose of discussing the business of the Association. Issues of a personal nature will not be debated or considered.
3. All speakers will practice fairness and courteous, respectful communication at all times.
4. Members, who wish to speak, will do so after being recognized by the chair.
5. Only one item, the immediately pending agenda item and/or the matter under discussion will be considered at a time.
6. Comments or questions must be related to the pending motion or report.
7. In the case of this virtual meeting, your comments will be completed in writing using the chat box feature of this Zoom meeting. These will be read out and answered by the most appropriate party.
8. Although everyone may comment (speak/type) twice on the same motion on the same day, someone who has not yet commented on it even once has preference over anyone who has already commented on it.
9. Points made once by an individual shall not be repeated by another individual.
