

Dear Nurse Practitioner,

We are reaching out to you today to provide an update on the Provincial Attachment System (PAS) incentive payments for longitudinal primary care NPs. The October 15th deadline for Health Authority (HA) employed NPs to request a payment has passed, and the verification process has been completed. Cheques are being processed and will be mailed out shortly to the address provided in your payment application. Any applicants who did not meet the PAS requirements will be notified by email.

A final opportunity to apply for the initial PAS incentive payment for employed NPs will be coming shortly, likely at the end of November, 2024. Any NP employees of Community Health Centers, clinics or other publicly funded models of primary care **AND** HA employed NPs who missed the previous October 15th deadline will be able to apply.

As soon as the new application link is available, a notification will be provided to the Health Authority Leads and through the NNPBC website, so stay tuned.

For NPs on service contracts the terms of PAS incentive payment are outlined in the contract and paid via your contract administrator.
